YMCA Employee & Volunteer Abuse Prevention Code of Conduct

YMCA staff and volunteers work by a code. This code was put in place to establish appropriate behavior. YMCA employees and volunteers are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that will not reflect adversely on the YMCA. If a single child left to the supervision of 1 employee or volunteer, that employee or volunteer is required to position themselves to be visible by others. Staff and volunteers shall never leave a child unsupervised. Staff and volunteers will portray a positive role model for youth.

Childcare: Staff may not release children to anyone other than the authorized parent or guardian. Staff who do not recognize the custodial parent or legal guardian must ask for identification and check it against file information.

Staff or volunteers may not be alone with children they meet in YMCA programs outside of the YMCA. This includes babysitting. SportsWorld Class Rules & Policies

- Classes:** Children must report to class on time (before the warm-up period) or they will not be permitted to attend class. Do not drop-off students more than 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the class. Students must be picked-up on time. **In the event that only 2 participants attend a class, the class time will be reduced to 45 minutes; 1 participant, 30 minutes.**
- Payments:** Payments are due by the scheduled due date. (See session calendar)
There is a \$10.00 late fee if tuition is not paid on time and/or you may forfeit your child's space in the class.
- Withdrawals:** We run year-round gymnastics and skating programs. Parents must inform the front desk of withdrawal so that the child can be removed from the roll. Otherwise, parents may be charged for the entire session.
- Make-ups:** No credits or refunds will be given for classes not attended. Tuition pays for your child's spot in class, although as a courtesy, students may *make-up two missed classes per session. *Excluding summer session.
All make-ups must be scheduled at the front desk. YMCA reserves the right to refuse any make-up based on our policy and procedure.
- Class Rules:** Appropriate gym attire consists of a leotard for girls and a form-fitting shirt and sports shorts for boys. We encourage two layers, especially for girls; panties underneath, or shorts over! No belts, jewelry, or watches are allowed in gym class. Long hair must be tied in a ponytail. Food and drinks are only permitted in the viewing areas, not on the gym or skate floors. No gum. No hats.
- Valuables:** Valuable items should not be brought to the facility. Lockable lockers are provided on the skate side. YMCA SportsWorld will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Parents/Visitors:** Parents/Visitors must sit in designated areas. Please do not talk to or otherwise distract the children participating in the classes. Any interruptions could result in serious injury. Parents/Visitors are not allowed on the gymnastics or skate floor.
- Holidays:** YMCA classes may be closed for classes during certain holidays. Please call the facility to confirm your class schedule.
- Membership:** YMCA SportsWorld reserves the right to cancel a student's membership or participation at any time.
